

# Iowa Buckskin Horse Association

## Year-End Nomination Rules

**\*\*Nomination Forms will be accepted until 7:00 A.M Friday May 4<sup>th</sup>\*\***

1. Owner and Exhibitor must be a current member in good standing with Iowa Buckskin Horse to be eligible for Year-End Awards. Points will not be calculated until current year membership is paid. Please include a copy of the current Iowa Buckskin Horse Association card (Owner's and Exhibitor's)
2. Nomination is on the horse in ABRA open classes. Horse/Rider combinations will be used in the Youth, Amateur and Open horse classes.
3. Points toward nominated classes will begin to be tracked when nominations are paid. ***You must show under a minimum of 12 judges to qualify for a Year-End or All-Around award. With the exception of Weanlings which must show under at least 6 judges to qualify for a Year-End award.*** The classes that will count toward All-Around will be all the classes that you have nominated for. You do not have to be nominated for all classes for All-Around Awards.
4. Nominations are for individual classes of your choice. No substitutions will be allowed after the Nominations Form has been turned in.
5. The board of Directors will handle all disputes. All decisions of the Board will be final.
6. Please use a separate Nomination Form per horse.
7. Nomination will be accepted after May 4<sup>th</sup> IF: You purchase a new horse, or become a new member during the year. The form must be to the Show Office before entering any classes.

8. It is the Nominator's responsibility to be familiar with these rules. Please keep a copy of all nominations for your records.
9. **The nomination fee is \$8.00 per class.**

Daily High Points at the Iowa Buckskin Horse Association shows and year-end awards will be figured in the following manner on the Iowa Buckskin Horse Association point system (Please note Iowa year-end point system may differ from ABRA point system)

**High Point Youth (13&under and 14-18), Amateur, Amateur Select and Open:** points are based on one horse/rider combination.

**High Point ABRA Open:** points are based on horse, no limit on exhibitors-only one color class counts for high point, all open ABRA classes count

**Grand Champion:** Halter horse of each sex division will receive at least one point more than any other yearling or older horse in its sex division provided at least three yearling or older horses were shown in the sex division. Should there not be at least three yearling and older entries in a sex division, no points will be given in that division. The grand Champion shall be chosen from the first place winner of the sex division. Every first place horse, in halter, must return from the Grand Champion class. Failure for a first place horse to return for the grand champion classes will cause such horse to forfeit any points earned in its halter class that day.

**Reserve champion:** halter horses of each sex division will receive as many points as any other yearling or older horse in its sex division except the Grand Champion. The reserve champion shall be chosen from the second place winner to the Grand Champion class and the first place winners of the other classes of the sex division. Every second place horse, in halter, must return for the choosing of reserve champion. Failure of a second place horse to

return for the champion class will cause such horse to forfeit any points earned in its halter class that day.
